## College Students' Union Election 2025-26

### Notice

#### **Subject: Receipt and Scrutiny of Nominations**

As per the Notification of College Students' Union Election 2025-26, scrutiny of received nominations will be held at the seminar Hall on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2026, Friday at 2.05 pm. The last date and hour for receipt of nominations is 13<sup>th</sup> February 2026, Friday at 2.00 pm. Students can drop their duly filled nomination form in **sealed cover** in the **Nomination drop box** which is kept in front of the Principal's Office. The Name of the post (as in the notification) shall be written on the sealed cover. The Nomination forms are available at the College Office, Returning Officer, and Assistant ROs and can be downloaded from the college website [www.gecidukki.ac.in](http://www.gecidukki.ac.in)

#### General Instructions to fill the Nomination Form

1. Only those full-time regular students whose names are on the Electoral Roll are eligible to take part in the election.
2. A candidate shall be considered eligible with respect to academic arrears for contesting College Union Elections only if all of the following conditions are satisfied:
  - a. The candidate has **passed all subjects of the completed semesters**, the results of which have been declared by the University, as on the date of filing the nomination.
  - b. The candidate has **appeared for all regular examinations of the completed semesters** and has **not been absent** from any regular examination, including examinations whose results are pending as on the date of filing nomination.
  - c. Subjects of the last completed semesters for which results have not yet been declared by the University as on the date of filing nomination shall not be taken into account for determining academic eligibility, provided the candidate has appeared for such examinations.
  - d. The following shall not be considered for the purpose of assessing academic eligibility of candidates:
    - i. Digital 101 MOOC course included in the 2024 curriculum

- ii. Minor courses
- iii. Honours courses
- iv. Challenge courses

3. Attendance eligibility will be assessed exclusively on the basis of the last completed semester of the programme. Attendance of the ongoing/current semester will not be considered for any purpose relating to election eligibility.

The minimum attendance required for eligibility will be as follows:

- Male students: 75%
- Female students: 73%
- Students with benchmark disabilities (PWD): 70%

Eligible attendance shall include approved condonation of attendance, as per the norms prescribed by the University.

Students who have been granted University-approved duty leave, and who thereby attain the prescribed minimum attendance, shall also be considered eligible for contesting the election.

The attendance eligibility condition shall be mandatory and uniformly applicable to:

- Candidate
- Proposer
- Seconder

4. Students who are currently subject to, or have previously been subject to, **disciplinary action** are **not eligible** to stand as **candidates** in the election, nor may they serve as **proposers** or **seconders**.

5. The upper age limit for contesting College Union Elections is **not exceeding twenty seven (27) years** (*Only students born after 08/02/1999 will be permitted to contest*). Age shall be calculated strictly with reference to the date of the Election Notification.

The upper age limit is applicable only for the **candidate**

7. The **Executive Committee** member posts are

8. Student can contest,-

- a. To the post of Office Bearer only **once** during the programme duration,
- b. To the post of Executive Committee member only **twice** during the programme duration.

9. A student whose name is there in the final electoral roll and satisfies the eligibility conditions mentioned above for being a candidate or proposer or seconder is given below.

10. A candidate may file nomination forms for more than one post. However, after the expiry of the withdrawal period, a student shall be permitted to contest as a candidate for only one (1) post at a time in a College Union Election.

If a candidate's name continues to appear against more than one post after the withdrawal period, the candidate shall be declared ineligible to contest for all such posts.

11. The Proposer and Seconder should not be a candidate for the same post.
12. No elector shall propose or second more than one candidate for the same post.
13. The Nomination form should be verified by the Staff Advisor and the Head of the Department of the Candidate.
14. The candidate shall produce the Hall ticket of the Previous regular examination which is signed by the invigilators on all exam days to prove he/she has **not been absent** from any regular examination.  
If the hall ticket is lost, get the attendance of the Previous regular examination verified by the examination cell of the college by producing a separate request.
15. The attendance and no disciplinary action eligibility of the proposer and seconder shall be verified by the respective staff advisors of the proposer and seconder before getting it verified by the staff advisors of the candidate.
16. The Nomination drop box will be closed at 2.00 pm on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2026, Friday
17. Entry to the scrutiny room is permitted strictly in accordance with university guidelines: for panel nominations, only two or three authorized agents may enter, while for individual nominations, entry is limited to the candidate or one authorized agent. Agents shall leave immediately after the scrutiny of the concerned nomination.
18. The Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in scrutiny, polling and counting rooms or nearby premises
